

Rainbow Tamborines

It's time to get the family band back together! You can harness your kids' creativity and musical talent by having them design their own rainbow tambourines. With just a few common household items and a little bit of time, your band will be ready to put on a real show. Here's everything you need to make your own rainbow tambourines:

Supplies:

-  Paper plates
-  A hole punch
-  6 to 10 bells
-  6 to 10 pieces of string
-  Paint, markers and/or crayons
-  A workstation your kids can paint or color on

Instructions:

1. Start by having your kids fold their paper plates neatly in half. You want to make sure the outer rim of the paper plates overlaps.
2. Then, an adult should use the hole punch to create 6 to 10 evenly spaced holes through both sides of the plate about half an inch from the outer edge.
3. Let your kids decorate their plates with paint, markers, crayons and anything else they want to create a rainbow design on their plate.
4. Tie one bell onto each piece of string. To make things easier, try to secure the bell in the middle of the piece of string.
5. Finally, feed the string through the holes on both sides of the tambourine (one hole on each side) to secure it in place.
